

NAVIGATION OF SLIDES IN KEYNOTE & POWERPOINT aVg Digital Vignettes

In addition to MicroSoft's and Apple's instructions for slide presentations, aVg Digital Vignettes use a few particular constructs to help the presenter with special effects which may give a clearer understanding of the teaching within each vignette.

Some slides require voice-over in order to affect greater accuracy and understanding of the material presented on that slide or about the training in general. Other slides are best served in a "self-advancing" manner than for the presenter to click to advance the animation. In some vignettes the automatic transition from slide to slide without the presenter's intervention is most effective. Some slides are most effective when viewed in silence.

VOICE-OVER: To hear the recorded teaching, simply

- touch or click on the "conversation bubble" associated with words or images on the slide

Note: Whenever voice-over is selected, the slide that speaks the words will have a black star with the word "back" on it which is clicked or touched to return to the slide from which the voice-over was selected.

SELF-ADVANCING:

- The word [AUTO] will appear on these slides

AUTOMATIC TRANSITION:

- These slides will NOT show the word [Click] at the end of the slide's animations

SILENCE:

- Each presenter must determine which is more effective. Bullit points in some cases are best served by silence. Questions are usually best served by a guided discussion before advancing.
