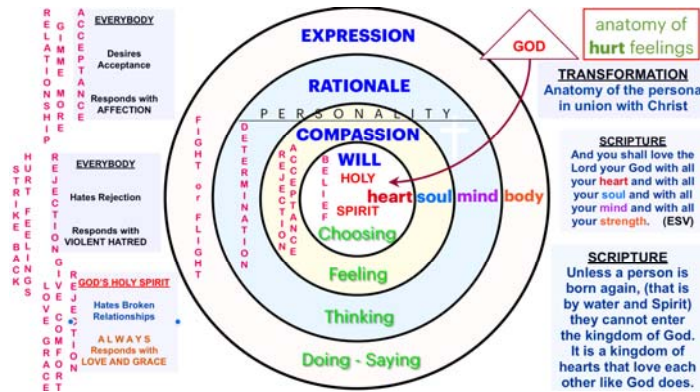


Volume 5 – Anatomy of hurt feelings
